- An official transcript where applicable
- Copy of Resume
- 2 written references (academic & character)

Further conditions apply for each discipline.

Applications will be accepted online. Hard copy applications will not be accepted.

To apply follow the steps as outlined below;

- 3. Download and complete the appropriate form
- 4. E-mail completed form and required documentation to the e-mail address specified on the form
- Only shortlisted candidates will be interviewed
- Scholarships will generally be offered only for the final year of study (Undergraduate Early Childhood Education Degrees exempt)
- Overseas Programs will not be considered if available locally
- Successful candidates will be subject to bonding in accordance with the GOJ bonding policy see website $\underline{www.mof.gov.jm}$
